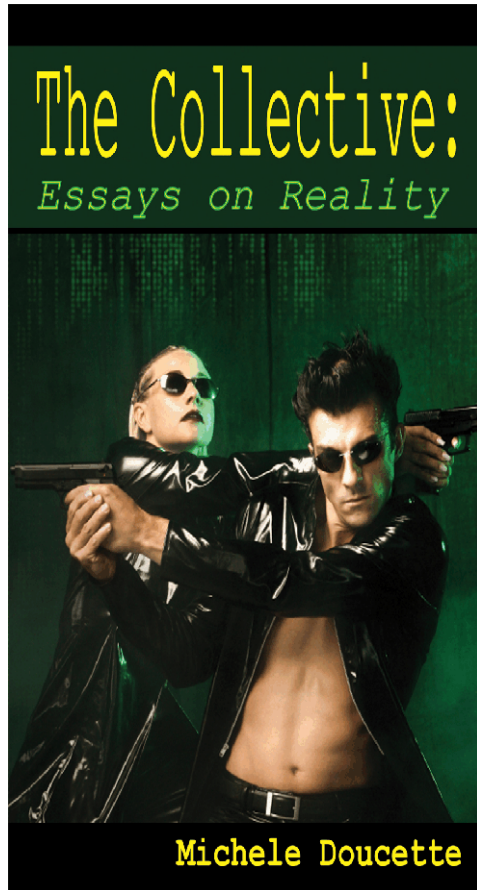


The Collective: Essays on Reality
